COMMISSION STAFF’S PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

I. INTRODUCTION

On September 10, 2021, Blackland Water Supply Corporation (Blackland WSC) and the City of Rockwall (Rockwall) (collectively, Petitioners) filed a petition to amend Blackland WSC’s water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 11305 under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.255(a) in Rockwall County, Texas in Docket No. 52551. In Order No. 2 in Docket No. 52551, the administrative law judge (ALJ) severed the CCN amendment proceeding, which became Docket No. 53262, the current proceeding. On March 25, 2022, the Petitioners filed the petition in Docket No. 53262 in accordance with Order No. 2 in Docket No. 52551. On May 13, 2022, the Petitioners’ filed errata with corrected exhibits.

On August 29, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 7, requiring the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a proposed procedural schedule for the further processing of the petition within 20 days after the date the Commission issues an order deciding the appeal of Order No. 6.

II. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On October 20, 2022, the Commission filed its Order on Appeal of Order No. 6. Staff now proposes the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for parties to file revised joint findings of fact and conclusions of law subsequent to Commission order on appeal	June 23, 2023

Staff has conferred with Petitioners regarding this proposed procedural schedule and is authorized to represent that the Petitioners support this schedule.

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the issuance of an order adopting the proposed procedural schedule above.
