**ORDER NO. 2**  
**FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE AND NOTICE**  
**SUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the March 25, 2022 petition of Blackland Water Supply Corporation and the City of Rockwall for approval to amend certificates of convenience and necessity in Rockwall County. On April 14, 2022, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on administrative completeness and proposed a procedural schedule.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete. Further, the ALJ finds that the petitioners have satisfied the notice requirements of 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.259(c) and (d) and that no further notice is required.

The following procedural schedule applies:

Deadline for Blackland WSC and Rockwall to file signed consent forms with the Commission	June 3, 2022
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	June 10, 2022
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed order, with findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs	June 24, 2022
