**GRANTING MOTION TO ABATE**


On October 27, 2022, AEP Texas, Inc., Hunt Energy Network, L.L.C., Broad Reach Power LLC, and SMT McAllen LLC (the Moving Parties) filed an agreed motion to abate this proceeding while the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) considers issues concerning distributed energy resources, relevant to this case, in other projects. The Moving Parties agree that the abatement may be lifted on the motion of any party, and that if the abatement is lifted and a new procedural schedule is established, the new schedule should preserve the timing of the existing schedule with respect to discovery, testimony,


and other deadlines. The Moving Parties state that Commission Staff is unopposed to the motion.

The motion is **GRANTED**, and this case is **ABATED**. The parties **SHALL** file a status report **no later than 15 calendar days after the conclusion of Commission Project Nos. 54224 and 51603** to indicate how the parties wish to proceed in this proceeding.
