**ORDER NO. 14**  
**FINDING SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND**  
**SOLICITING MOTION TO ADMIT SUPPLEMENTAL EVIDENCE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the supplemental notice provided by Southeast Water Supply Corporation and Concord Robbins Water Supply Corporation for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Leon County in response to Order No. 11 filed no June 6, 2023 requiring clarification on notice.

On June 16 and June 20, 2023, the applicants filed proof of notice which included an affidavit of notice to landowners, a copy of a sample notice to landowners with attached maps, and a list of the landowners owning 25 acres or more according to appraisal district information, as well as a cover letter and a map containing appraisal district information of landowner parcels overlayed with the requested area.


On June 30, 2023, Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation regarding notice.

The administrative law judge finds the notice, as supplemented, sufficient.

By September 13, 2023, the parties must file a motion to admit the supplemental information filed in response to Order No. 13 by Concord on August 2 and 7, 2023, and Commission Staff's recommendation filed on August 14, 2023.
