COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On March 1, 2022, the Southeast Water Supply Corporation (Southeast WSC) and Concord Robbins Water Supply Corporation (Concord WSC) (jointly, the Applicants) filed an application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) rights in Leon County. Concord WSC, water CCN No. 11717, seeks approval to acquire facilities and to transfer all of the water service area from Southeast WSC under water CCN No. 12180. On March 14, 2022, March 21, 2022, March 22, 2022, March 24, 2022, and March 25, 2022, the Applicants filed supplemental information.

On March 3, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 1, requiring the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file comments on the administrative completeness of the application, proposed notice, and to propose a procedural schedule by April 1, 2022. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

In accordance with 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff is awaiting additional financial documents from the Applicants. Accordingly, Staff requests that the deadline for parties to file comments on the administrative completeness of the application, proposed notice, and to propose a procedural schedule be extended to April 15, 2022. Staff has conferred with the Applicants who are unopposed to the extension.

II. REQUEST TO RESTYLE DOCKET

Staff respectfully requests that the docket be restyled as *Application of Southeast Water Supply Corporation and Concord Robbins Water Supply Corporation for Sale, Transfer, or Merger of Facilities and Certificate Rights in Leon County*.

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests an order consistent with the foregoing request.
