ORDER NO. 3
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING
NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the March 2, 2022 application of application of SJWTX, Inc. dba Canyon Lake Water Service Company for a certificate of convenience and necessity in Blanco County.

On June 6, 2022, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on administrative completeness and proposed a procedural schedule.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs the petitioners to provide notice of the application as described in the June 6, 2022 memorandums of Patricia Garcia attached to Commission Staff's recommendation, using the included forms.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for SJWTX to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice and map sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	July 18, 2022
Deadline for Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	July 28, 2022
Deadline to intervene	30 days after last date notice is issued
