# **COMMISSION STAFF'S STATUS REPORT**

On March 15, 2022, the administrative law judge issued Order No. 2 requiring the staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a report on the status of this proceeding by or on May 2, 2022. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

## I. STATUS REPORT

On March 11, 2022, Commission Staff filed within this docket its petition to revoke M.A.B.D.D. Inc. (MABDD)'s certificate of public convenience and necessity (CCN). Staff's petition was sent by certified mail to MABDD's last known address as stated within CCN number 20661 issued by the Texas Water Commission on December 19, 1986. There is no address associated with MABDD within Commission records. However, Commission Staff, after reasonable investigation, identified an additional address associated with MABDD listed in records of the Texas Comptroller. In order to satisfy the notice requirements under the Administrative Procedure Act and Texas Administrative Code, Commission Staff will file an amended petition in this matter and provide a copy of the same to the addresses identified after reasonable investigation.
