ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT
AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the March 10, 2022 application of Stonebridge Water Supply Corporation and Cross Timbers Water Supply Corporation for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Denton County.

On April 8, 2022, Commission Staff filed recommendations on administrative completeness of the application and notice.

The administrative law judge finds the application administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

By May 9, 2022, the applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the April 8, 2022 memorandum of James Harville. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicants must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

By June 9, 2022, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness, proposed notice, and proposed procedural schedule for further processing, if appropriate.
