**COMMISSION STAFF’S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

On March 11, 2022, Big Easy Agua LLC (Big Easy) filed an application to obtain a water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) in Colorado County. The requested service area consists of 1,039 acres and 0 connections.

On August 16, 2022, the administrative law judge filed Order No. 6 establishing a procedural schedule for this docket.

**I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. When Staff submitted its procedural schedule recommendation on August 12, 2022, it was based on the incorrect assumption that final maps had already been prepared, hence Staff’s recommendation that final maps be provided within five days on August 18, 2022. Staff typically needs 30 days to properly prepare final maps for applicants, and this case is no different. Accordingly, Staff respectfully requests that all the deadlines established in Order No. 6 be moved back by thirty days to give Staff the opportunity to follow its normal procedure in preparing final maps. Staff has conferred with a representative of Big Easy and is authorized to represent they are unopposed to the extension request.

**II. CONCLUSION**

For the reasons detailed above, Staff respectfully requests that all the deadlines established by Order No. 6 be moved back by thirty days.
