COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On March 11, 2022, Big Easy Agua LLC (Big Easy) filed an application to obtain a water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) in Colorado County. The requested service area consists of 1,039 acres and 0 connections.

On August 17, 2022, the administrative law judge filed Order No. 7 requiring the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a final recommendation on the application by October 10, 2022. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff requires more information from Big Easy to complete its review of its application, and Staff plans on proffering discovery on Big Easy to obtain said information. Accordingly, Staff respectfully requests that Staff's deadline to file a final recommendation on the application be extended to November 11, 2022.

II. CONCLUSION

For the reasons detailed above, Staff respectfully requests that its deadline to file a final recommendation on the application be extended to November 11, 2022
