COG has distributed the EOP to local Jurisdictions, including regional TDEM personnel and including ECTOR County Emergency Management Coordinator;

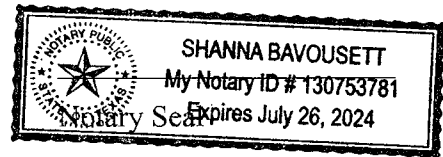
COG has a Business Continuity Plan related to returning to normal operations after an emergency event or situation;



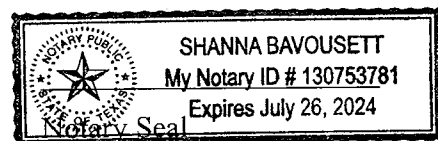
