I, Clinton Bailey, P.E., swear or affirm that as a Municipally Owned Utility operating in the State of Texas and the Electric Reliability Council of Texas (ERCOT) region and control system, confirms the following:

“I am the City Manager for the City of Fredericksburg (FBG), which is an incorporated municipality in the State of Texas.

FBG operates an electric distribution utility system in the State of Texas and the Electric Reliability Council of Texas power region.

The Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) developed to comply with the updated 16 TAC §25.53. Electric Service Emergency Operations Plan Rule, has been distributed to FBG Managers and Operations personnel;

FBG executives and Operations personnel have received training on the updated EOP;

In accordance with the updated 16 TAC §25.53. Electric Service Emergency Operations Plan Rule, a drill (tabletop exercise) for FBG Operations personnel will be conducted as required;

FBG will notify Commission Emergency Management Personnel and regional TDEM representative(s) prior to the drill;

FBG has distributed the EOP to local Jurisdictions, including regional TDEM personnel and including The Gillespie County Emergency Management Coordinator;


FBG has a Business Continuity Plan related to returning to normal operations after an emergency event or situation;

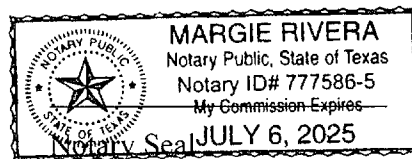



The §25.53. Electric Service Emergency Operations Plans Rule is applicable to FBG.



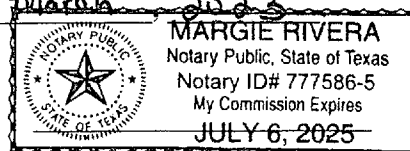


