I, Mark Mayo, swear or affirm that as a Municipally Owned Utility operating in the State of Texas and the Electric Reliability Council of Texas (ERCOT) region and control system, confirms the following:

“I am the City Manager for the City of Luling (COL), which is an incorporated municipality in the State of Texas.

COL operates an electric distribution utility system in the State of Texas and the Electric Reliability Council of Texas power region.

The Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) developed to comply with the updated 16 TAC §25.53. Electric Service Emergency Operations Plan Rule, has been distributed to COL Managers and Operations personnel;

COL executives and Operations personnel have received training on the updated EOP;

In accordance with the updated 16 TAC §25.53. Electric Service Emergency Operations Plan Rule, a drill (tabletop exercise) for COL Operations personnel was completed prior to the Winter Season in CY2022, and will be conducted in CY2023 as required;

COL will notify Commission Emergency Management Personnel and regional TDEM representative(s) prior to the drill;

COL has distributed the EOP to local Jurisdictions, including regional TDEM personnel and including the Caldwell County Emergency Management Coordinator;

COL has a Business Continuity Plan related to returning to normal operations after an emergency event or situation;


