COB has a Business Continuity Plan related to returning to normal operations after an emergency event or situation.

COB's emergency management personnel who are designated to interact with local, state, and federal emergency management officials during emergency events have received the latest IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, and IS-800 National Incident Management System training.
