
My name is Brett Mattison. I am over eighteen years of age and am competent to make this Affidavit. I am the President and Chief Operating Officer for Southwestern Electric Power Company (SWEPCO). The facts contained herein are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief:

1. Relevant operating personnel within SWEPCO are familiar with the contents of the emergency operations plan (EOP) and have received training on the applicable contents and execution of the EOP, and such personnel are instructed to follow the applicable portions of the EOP except to the extent deviations are appropriate as a result of specific circumstances during the course of an emergency;
2. The EOP has been reviewed and approved by the appropriate executives;
3. Drills have been conducted to the extent required by 16 TAC § 25.53(f);
4. The EOP or an appropriate summary has been distributed to local jurisdictions as needed;
5. SWEPCO maintains business continuity plans that address returning to normal operations after disruptions caused by an incident; and
6. SWEPCO's emergency management personnel designated to interact with local, state, and federal emergency management officials during emergency events have received IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, and IS-800 National Incident Management System (NIMS) training.
7. SWEPCO did not make a change to the EOP that materially affects how SWEPCO would respond to an emergency.
