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Executive Summary

This Executive Summary provides an overview of 174 Power Global Retail Texas, LLC d/b/a Chariot Energy and Tristar Energy's process for maintaining all aspects of 174 Power Global Retail Texas' business in the event of various disasters in compliance with 16 Tex. Admin. Code §25.53, Public Utility Commission of Texas ("PUCT") substantive rule regarding Electric Service Emergency Operations Plan ("Rule").

Since 2019, 174 Power Global Retail Texas, LLC has operated and conducted business as a retail electric provider ("REP") under REP Certificate No. 10260 under its assumed name "Chariot Energy." See Docket Nos. 49030 and 49315. Chariot Energy filed its Emergency Operations Plan with the PUCT on April 15, 2022.

On May 16, 2022, 174 Power Global Retail Texas, LLC filed an application in Docket No. 53482 to amend its REP Certificate No. 10260 to add the assumed name of "Tristar Energy" to its certificate. The Commission issued a Notice of Approval on July 11, 2022 approving 174 Power Global Retail Texas, LLC's application and its requested assumed name of Tristar Energy.

Therefore, in accordance with 16 TAC § §25.53, 174 Power Global Retail Texas, LLC files an updated Executive Summary and Emergency Operations Plan ("EOP" or "Plan") applicable to both of its assumed names, Chariot Energy and Tristar Energy. 174 Power Global Retail Texas, LLC's Executive Summary, EOP, and related annexes apply to both Chariot Energy and Tristar Energy, and all references to 174 Power Global Retail Texas, LLC in the Executive Summary and the EOP shall include both Chariot Energy and Tristar Energy.

174 Power Global Retail Texas, LLC's Emergency Operations Plan, including all attachments and annexes, describe the policies and processes for 174 Power Global Retail Texas, LLC to follow during emergency operations. 174 Power Global Retail Texas, LLC will respond to emergency situations and activate the EOP and the appropriate annex(s) in such emergencies.

This Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) and related annexes describes the policies and processes for 174 Power Global Retail Texas, LLC d/b/a Chariot Energy and Tristar Energy to follow during emergency operations in accordance with the requirements of Chapter 25, Subchapter C, §25.53, of the PUCT Electric Substantive Rules.

Therefore, in accordance with 16 TAC § §25.53, 174 Power Global Retail Texas, LLC provides the following information on behalf of its assumed names Chariot Energy and Tristar Energy.

This EOP, including all attachments and annexes, applies to, and will be used by 174 Power Global Retail Texas, LLC to respond to emergency situations and activate the EOP and the appropriate annex(s) in such emergencies.

The following events will trigger the activation and implementation of 174 Power Global Retail Texas, LLC's EOP as necessary to the region or affected area of Texas.





EOP Training, Drill Exercise and Distribution

REP Required Drills

- REPs must conduct or participate in at least one drill each calendar year to test its EOP.
- Following an annual drill, the entity must assess the effectiveness of its emergency response and revise its EOP as needed.
- If the entity operates in a hurricane evacuation zone as defined by TDEM, at least one of the annual drills must include a test of its hurricane annex.



• An entity that has activated its EOP in response to an emergency is not required, under this subsection, to conduct or participate in a drill in the calendar year in which the EOP was activated.

Drill Notification

An entity conducting an annual drill must, at least 30 days prior to the date of at least one drill each calendar year, notify commission staff, using the method and form prescribed by commission staff on the commission's website, and the appropriate TDEM District Coordinators, by email or other written form, of the date, time, and location of the drill.




It is impossible to provide specific information for all situations. There is no guarantee implied by this plan that perfect response to disaster emergency incidents will be practical or possible. Therefore, this four-phased plan, as described below, plan is a guide for 174 Power Global Retail Texas, LLC to use help prepare for emergency planning, response, and evacuation. Preparation will increase the margin of safety in an emergency. While the types of emergencies vary there are two that affect the business and the employees differently; emergencies that prevent us from working in the office space, and emergencies that can force employees to leave the city. We have purposely broken them into two because it requires two different responses. However, it is ultimately up to each employee to do what is best for their health and safety. Communicating effectively with management will aid in preparing for changes in the plan.

If the State Operations Center (SOC) declares an emergency event, 174 Power Global Retail Texas, LLC is prepared to ensure business continuity of daily operations as listed in this document. Depending on the type and severity of the situations 174 Power Global Retail Texas, LLC will abide by the State's request up to and including evacuation, remaining at the office, working from home or temporary location, etc. 174 Power Global Retail Texas, LLC is prepared to do everything within the capability of its employees and systems to meet the needs of the customers for the duration of the State issued emergency. Based on the type of emergency, 174 Power Global Retail Texas, LLC employees will follow either the evacuation or non-evacuation plan. Management and employees are asked to keep open lines of communication to address business continuity issues.





- Should the car stop between floors and the door opens, do not ever attempt to climb out or jump to the floor below, as help will be there in minutes to assist with the situation.




Fire Emergency

- Fire Evacuation Plan / Fire During Working Hours
 - IF YOU SEE FIRE, SMOKE OR SMELL SOMETHING BURNING
 - Immediately call the Fire Department at 911 and/or activate the fire alarm pull station.
 - o Call Property Management at
 - Isolate the fire, if possible, by closing the door.
 - Contact the Property Management office, 24-hour Lobby Security, and 911 and give the location and severity of the fire.
 - Property Management Office:
 - 24-Hour Lobby Security Console: _____
 - If directed to evacuate by the fire department or the Property Management Office, or if unsafe conditions warrant leaving the floor, evacuate DOWN to the next re-entry floor by using the fire exit stairs...never use the elevator!
 - IF YOU THINK YOU SMELL SMOKE
 - Immediately call Property Management at location and characteristic of the odor.
 - IF YOU HEAR THE FIRE ALARM
 - Direct all occupants on the floor in alarm to the fire exit stairs and await further instructions.
- Fire Evacuation Plan / Fire After Working Hours
 - IF YOU SEE FIRE, SMELL SMOKE OR HEAR A FIRE ALARM
 - Immediately call the Fire Department at 911 and/or activate the fire alarm pull station.
 - Call the lobby security console at
 - Isolate the fire, if possible, by closing the door.
 - If directed to evacuate by the fire department or the Property Management Office, or if unsafe conditions warrant leaving the floor, evacuate DOWN to the next re-entry floor by using the fire exit stairs... never use the elevator!






Hurricane Annex

When a hurricane warning and evacuation order has been given by the <u>National Weather</u> <u>Service</u> and Civil Defense Authorities; the Property Management Office will notify all tenants of the closing of the building. Notification will be given by phone and by notices posted in public areas, lobbies, elevators, and entry areas. Tenants not reached by phone will have evacuation
