Declaration Energy LLC dba Energy Texas ("Energy Texas") hereby submits its annual Emergency Operations Plan ("EOP") update pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code ("TAC") § 25.53(c)(3). This update applies to Energy Texas (REP Certification No. 10281). As supported by the attached Affidavit, Energy Texas made no changes to its EOP in the previous calendar year that materially affects how it would respond to an emergency. Energy Texas continues to comply with all applicable provisions of 16 TAC § 25.53 regarding its existing EOP that was previously submitted to the PUCT and to ERCOT.¹ Further, Energy Texas has no changes to its emergency contact list.

Lastly, Energy Texas has attached both an Attestation of its highest-ranking representative in compliance with 16 TAC § 25.53(c)(3)(B)(ii) and an affidavit of its highest-ranking representative in compliance with 16 TAC § 25.53(c)(3)(B)(iii).²
