**PATTERN ENERGY GROUP LP’S JOINT ANNUAL UPDATE TO ITS EMERGENCY
OPERATIONS PLAN PURSUANT TO PUC SUBST. R. 25.53(c)(3) FOR 2023**

Pattern Energy Group LP (“Pattern”) hereby submits its Joint Annual Emergency Operations Plan (“EOP”) update pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code (“TAC”) § 25.53(c)(3). This update applies to all power generation companies included in Pattern’s previously-submitted EOP, which include: Pattern Gulf Wind LLC (PGC registration number 20258), Logan’s Gap Wind LLC (PGC registration number 20351), Pattern Panhandle Wind LLC (PGC registration number 20317), Pattern Panhandle Wind 2 LLC (PGC registration number 20320), and G.S.E One LLC (Phoenix Solar) (PGC registration number 20496). As supported by the attached Affidavit, Pattern made no changes to its EOP in the previous calendar year that materially affect how it would respond to an emergency. Pattern continues to comply with all applicable provisions of 16 TAC § 25.53 regarding its existing EOP that was previously submitted to the PUCT and to ERCOT.¹

Further, Pattern has made certain revisions to its emergency contact list including addition of the following primary emergency contacts, which it hereby reports to the Commission pursuant to 16 TAC § 25.53(c)(3)(B)(i):



Code ("TAC") § 25.53(c)(4)(C), I further swear and affirm that: (i) all relevant operating personnel are familiar with and have received training on the applicable contents and execution of the EOP, and such personnel are instructed to follow the applicable portions of the EOP except to the extent deviations are appropriate as a result of specific circumstances during the course of an emergency; (ii) the EOP has been reviewed and approved by the appropriate executives; (iii) drills have been conducted to the extent required by 16 TAC § 25.53(f); (iv) the EOP or an appropriate summary has been distributed to local jurisdictions as needed; (v) that Pattern maintains a business continuity plan that addresses returning to normal operations after disruption caused by an incident; and (vi) Pattern's emergency management personnel who are designated to interact with local, state, and federal emergency management officials during emergency events will have received the latest IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, and IS-800 National Incident Management Systems training no later than June 1, 2023.


