This update applies to all power generation companies included in Impact’s previously-submitted EOP, which include: Impact Solar 1, LLC. As supported by the attached Affidavit, Impact made no changes to its EOP in the previous calendar year that materially affects how it would respond to an emergency. Impact continues to comply with all applicable provisions of 16 TAC § 25.53 regarding its existing EOP that was previously submitted to the PUCT and to ERCOT. Further, Impact has no changes to its emergency contact list.


