## EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN AFFIDAVIT OF BLUE JAY SOLAR I, LLC

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BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared **PAOLO ROMANACCI**, who, after being duly sworn, stated on their oath that the following statements contained below are true and correct, to the best of their knowledge:

1. My name is **PAOLO ROMANACCI**. My business address is **100 BRICKSTONE SQUARE, SUITE 300, ANDOVER, MA 01810**. I am over the age of 18 and fully competent to make this affidavit. I have personal knowledge of the facts contained herein, and to the best of my knowledge, they are true and correct.
2. I am currently employed as **PRESIDENT AND CEO**, the highest-ranking representative, official, or officer with binding authority over power generation company (“PGC”) **Blue Jay Solar I, LLC**, PGC No. **20576**. I am authorized to make this affidavit on its behalf.
3. **Blue Jay Solar I, LLC** filed the Executive Summary, Affidavits, and Emergency Operations Plan (“EOP”) on April 14, 2022, in Project. No. 53385, Item 472.
4. On behalf of **Blue Jay Solar I, LLC**, I affirm the following:
  - i. Because **Blue Jay Solar I, LLC** is in the midst of development and has not yet begun commercial operations, relevant operating personnel have not yet received training on the applicable contents and execution of the Emergency Operations Plan (“EOP”) that is being filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (“PUCT”) in Project No. 53385. Such personnel will be trained and instructed to follow the applicable portions of the EOP, except to the extent deviations are appropriate as a result of specific circumstances during the course of an emergency, prior to the project’s commercial operations date (“COD”).
  - ii. The EOP has been reviewed and approved by the appropriate executives.
  - iii. Because the PGC has not yet begun commercial operations, drills have not yet been conducted pursuant to subsection (f) of 16 TAC § 25.53. **BLUE JAY SOLAR I, LLC** intends to conduct a drill to the extent required by 16 TAC § 25.53(f) following COD and will provide notice to PUCT Staff after the completion of the drill.
  - iv. The EOP or an appropriate summary will be distributed to local jurisdictions if deemed necessary.
  - v. **Blue Jay Solar I, LLC** maintains a business continuity plan that addresses returning to normal operations after disruptions caused by an incident.
  - vi. **Blue Jay Solar I, LLC**’s emergency management personnel who are designated to interact with local, state, and federal emergency management officials during emergency events have received the latest IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, and IS-800 National Incident Management System training.



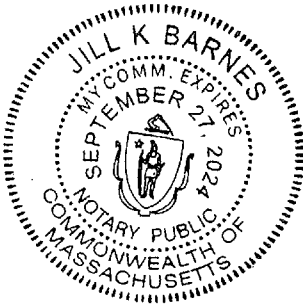


