- 5. Drills have been conducted to the extent required by subsection (f) of 16 Texas Administrative Code § 25.53.
- 6. The EOP or an appropriate summary has been distributed to local jurisdictions as needed.
- 7. GVEC maintains a business continuity plan those addresses returning to normal operations after disruptions caused by an incident.
- 8. GVEC's emergency management personnel who are designated to interact with local, state, and federal emergency management officials during emergency events have received the latest IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, and IS-800 National Incident Management System training.
