- 1. I am John Harvey VP of Operations of TPC Group, LLC ("TPC Group") and highest-ranking officer, official, or officer with binding authority over TPC Group. I have personal knowledge of the facts stated in this affidavit and they are true and correct.
- 2. TPC Group is registered with the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("PUCT") as a power generation company.
- 3. TPC Group filed an Emergency Operations Plan (the "Plan") in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code ("TAC") § 25.53 on April 18, 2022.
- 4. No changes have been made to TPC Group's list of emergency contacts as provided under 16 TAC § 25.53(c)(4)(B) since TPC Group's filing on April 18, 2022.
- 5. No changes have been made to the Plan that materially affect how TPC Group would respond to an emergency since TPC Group's filing on April 18, 2022.
- 6. All relevant operating personnel are familiar with and have received training on the applicable contents and execution of the Plan, and such personnel are instructed to follow the applicable portions of the Plan except to the extent deviations are appropriate as a result of specific circumstances during the course of an emergency.
- 7. The Plan has been reviewed and approved by appropriate executives.
- 8. TPC Group has conducted a drill in accordance to Substantive Rule 25.53(f).
- 9. The Plan or an appropriate summary has been distributed to local jurisdictions as needed.
- 10. TPC Group maintains a business continuity plan that addresses returning to normal operations after disruptions caused by an incident.
- 11. TPC Group's emergency management personnel who are designated to interact with local, state, and federal emergency management officials during emergency events have received the latest IS-100.b, IS-200.b, IS-700.a, and IS-800.b National Incident Management System training.
