

I, Francis X. McGovern, swear or affirm the following on behalf of Clearview Power, Inc., a Retail Electric Provider operating in the State of Texas:

- a. Relevant operating personnel are familiar with and have received training on the applicable contents and execution of the Emergency Operations Plan ("EOP"), and such personnel are instructed to follow the applicable portions of the EOP except to the extent deviations are appropriate as a result of specific circumstances during the course of an emergency;
- b. The EOP has been reviewed and approved by the appropriate executives;
- c. The EOP was activated in January 2022 in lieu of a drill; Clearview sold its book of TX customers in 2022 and currently has no active accounts.
- d. EOP has not been distributed to local jurisdictions as Clearview is a REP
- e. Clearview maintains a business continuity plan that addresses returning to normal operations after disruptions caused by an incident; and
- f. Clearview believes as a REP without any ownership or control over generation or transmission assets that it has no obligation to designate emergency management personnel to interact with local, state, and federal emergency management officials during emergency events, or receive the latest IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, and IS-800 National Incident Management System training.
