Subject: Notification of Emergency Operations Plan Activation

Dear Commission,

This letter is to inform the Commission that on August 24, 2023 at approximately 07:15 hrs., Rayburn Energy Station LLC. activated Section 3.7 titled Weather Emergency Extreme Heat of its rule 25.53 Emergency Operations Plan filed with the Public Utilities Commission of Texas. Activation of the EOP occurred due to and ERCOT OCN for forecasted extreme hot weather throughout the ERCOT region and an ERCOT market notification stating ERCOT has issued a Watch for a projected reserve capacity shortage with no market solution available for Thursday, August 24, 2023 HE 19:00 – 21:00, which causes a risk for an EEA event. As per the filed EOP, Rayburn Energy Station LLC. executed the actions outlined in Section 3.7 Weather Emergency Extreme Heat until ERCOT cancelled the watch and OCN. Lastly, it is the understanding of Rayburn Energy Station LLC. that this activation of its Emergency Operations Plan satisfies the annual drill requirement per Rule 25.53.
