



BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared, and who, after being duly sworn, stated on his or her oath he or she is entitled to make this Affidavit, and that the statements contained below are true and correct.

I, Chris Coffman, swear or affirm that as a Municipally Owned Utility operating in the State of Texas and the Electric Reliability Council of Texas (ERCOT) region and control system, confirms the following:

1. I am the City Administrator for the City of Granbury (COG), which is an incorporated home-rule municipality in the State of Texas.
2. COG operates an electric distribution utility system in the State of Texas and the ERCOT power region;
3. The Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) developed to comply with the updated 16 TAC §25.53. Electric Service Emergency Operations Plans rule, has been distributed to COG Managers and Operations personnel;
4. COG executives and Operations personnel are familiar with and have received training on the applicable contents and execution of the updated EOP, and such personnel are instructed to follow the applicable portions of the EOP except to the extent deviations are appropriate as a result of specific circumstances during the course of an emergency;
5. The EOP has been reviewed and approved by the appropriate executives.
6. In accordance with the updated 16 TAC §25.53. Electric Service Emergency Operations Plan Rule, a drill (tabletop exercise) for COG Operations personnel was completed prior to the Winter Season in CY2022, and will continue to be conducted as required;
7. COG notified Commission Emergency Management Personnel and regional TDEM representative(s) at least thirty (30) days prior to the drill;
8. COG has distributed the EOP to local Jurisdictions, including regional TDEM personnel and The Hood County Emergency Management Coordinator;
9. COG has a Business Continuity Plan related to returning to normal operations after an emergency event or situation;
10. COG's emergency management personnel who are designated to interact with


local, state, and federal emergency management officials during emergency events have received the latest IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, and IS-800 National Incident Management System training.




