I, James Coleman, swear or affirm that as an Electric Cooperative operating in the State of Texas and the Electric Reliability Council of Texas (ERCOT) region and control system, confirms the following:

"I am the General Manager of Jackson Electric Cooperative, Inc. (JEC), which is a Texas electric cooperative corporation."

JEC operates an electric distribution utility system in the State of Texas and the Electric Reliability Council of Texas power region.

The Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) developed to comply with the updated 16 TAC §25.53. Electric Service Emergency Operations Plan Rule, has been distributed to JEC Managers and Operations personnel;

JEC executives and Operations personnel have received training on the updated EOP;

In accordance with the updated 16 TAC §25.53. Electric Service Emergency Operations Plan Rule, a drill (tabletop exercise) for JEC Operations personnel will be conducted as required;

JEC will notify Commission Emergency Management Personnel and regional TDEM representative(s) prior to the drill;

JEC has distributed the EOP to local Jurisdictions, including regional TDEM personnel and all Counties in the JEC service area;

JEC has a Business Continuity Plan related to returning to normal operations after an emergency event or situation;

JEC's emergency management personnel who are designated to interact with local, state, and federal emergency management officials during emergency events have received the latest IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, and IS-800 National Incident Management System training.


