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Emergency Operating Plan Executive Summary

This Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) applies to HiVolt Power II, LLC (HP), which is registered with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUCT) as a Power Generation Company (PGC). The purpose of this EOP is to detail the requirements and actions for emergency operations and to communicate operational procedures to HP employees. The EOP is provided to all HP employees to promote safety, responsiveness, reliability, and continued operations during emergency situations.

1. My name is Joshua W. Evans. I am the Chief Executive Officer of HiVolt Power II, LLC ("HPH") and the highest-ranking officer with binding authority over HPH.

2. I swear or affirm that in my capacity as CEO of HPH, I have personal knowledge of the facts stated in the Emergency Operations Plan ("EOP") submitted to ERCOT and filed into Project No. 53385.

3. Relevant operating personnel are familiar with and have received training on the applicable contents and execution of the EOP, and such personnel have been instructed to follow the applicable portions of the EOP except to the extent deviations are appropriate as a result of specific circumstances during the course of an emergency.

4. The EOP has been reviewed and approved by the appropriate executives.


5. HPH intends to conduct a drill consistent with subsection (f) of PUC Subst. R. § 25.53 during this calendar year and will provide notice to Commission Staff at least 30 days before that drill is conducted.

6. The EOP or an appropriate summary has been distributed to local jurisdictions as needed.

7. HPH maintains a business continuity plan addressing return to normal operations after disruptions caused by an incident.

8. HPH does not have any emergency management personnel designated to interact with local, state, and federal emergency management officials during emergency events. Any future emergency management personnel designated will complete the latest IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, and IS-800 National Incident Management Systems training prior to interacting with any of the designated officials during an emergency.

9. I further swear or affirm the information, statements and/or representations contained in the Emergency Operations Plan are true, complete, and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief."

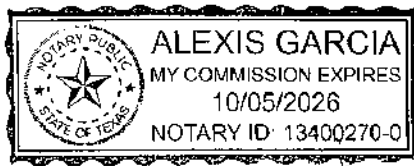
