COL has distributed the EOP to local Jurisdictions, including regional TDEM personnel and The Polk County Emergency Management Coordinator.

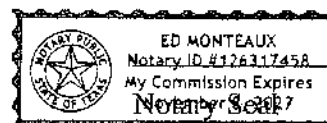
COL has a Business Continuity Plan related to returning to normal operations after an emergency event or situation.
