VEC executives and Operations personnel have received training on the updated EOP;


Drills have been conducted to the extent required by 16 TAC §25.53(f);

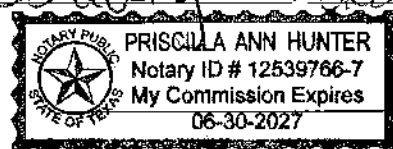

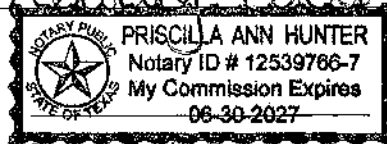
