- 9. BTU has a Business Continuity Plan related to returning to normal operations after an emergency event or situation.
- 10. BTU's emergency management personnel who are designated to interact with local, state, and federal emergency management officials during emergency events have received the latest IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, and IS-800 National Incident Management System training.
