BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared, and who, after being duly sworn, stated on his or her oath he or she is entitled to make this Affidavit, and that the statements contained below are true and correct.

I, Gary Miller, am of sound mind, capable of making this affidavit, and personally equipped with the facts stated herein. As the highest-ranking representative with binding authority over a Municipally Owned Utility operating in the State of Texas and the Electric Reliability Council of Texas (ERCOT) region and control system, I swear or affirm the following facts are true and correct:

1. I am the General Manager for Bryan Texas Utilities (BTU), which is an incorporated home-rule municipality in the State of Texas.
2. BTU operates an electric utility system in the State of Texas and the ERCOT power region.
3. The Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) developed to comply with the updated 16 TAC §25.53. Electric Service Emergency Operations Plans Rule has been distributed to BTU Managers and Operations personnel.
4. BTU executives and Operations personnel are familiar with and have received training on the applicable contents and execution of the updated EOP, and such personnel are instructed to follow the applicable portions of the EOP except to the extent deviations are appropriate as a result of specific circumstances during the course of an emergency.
5. The EOP has been reviewed and approved by the appropriate executives.
6. In accordance with 6 TAC §215.53(f), drills (tabletop exercises) have been conducted as required.
7. BTU will notify Commission Emergency Management Personnel and regional TDEM representative(s) at least thirty (30) days prior to the drill.
8. BTU has distributed the EOP to local Jurisdictions, including regional TDEM personnel and the Brazos County Emergency Management Coordinator.
9. BTU has a Business Continuity Plan related to returning to normal operations after an emergency event or situation.
10. BTU's emergency management personnel who are designated to interact with local, state, and federal emergency management officials during emergency events have received the latest IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, and IS-800 National Incident Management System training.




