SWTEC operates an electric distribution utility system in the State of Texas and the Electric Reliability Council of Texas power region.

SWTEC has adopted an Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) which complies with the updated 16 TAC §25.53. Electric Service Emergency Operations Plan Substantive Rule adopted by the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUCT);

The EOP has been distributed to SWTEC Managers and Operations personnel;

SWTEC executives and Operations personnel have received training on the EOP;


Drills have been conducted to the extent required by 16 TAC §25.53(f);

SWTEC has distributed the EOP or an appropriate summary of the EOP to all local jurisdictions as needed, including all Counties in the SWTEC service area;


SWTEC has adopted and maintains a Business Continuity Plan related to returning to normal operations after an emergency event or situation;

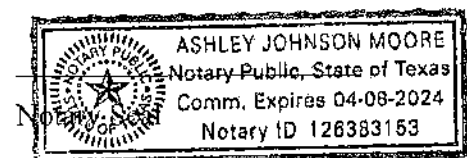



“The §25.53. Electric Service Emergency Operations Plans Substantive Rule is applicable to SWTEC.



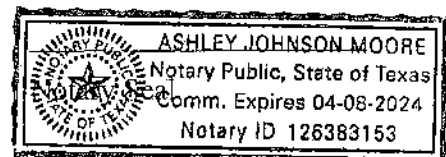


