BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared who swore an oath that the following facts are true:

- 1. My name is Andrew Bowman. I am President of Jupiter Power LLC and the highest-ranking representative, official, or officer with binding authority over Flower Valley LLC ("Flower Valley"). I am over 18 years of age, of sound mind, and competent and authorized to make this affidavit on behalf of Flower Valley. I have personal knowledge of the matters described herein.
- 2. Flower Valley is registered with the Public Utility Commission of Texas as a power generation company and an indirect subsidiary of Jupiter Power LLC. The Flower Valley facility is a battery energy storage system.
- 3. Flower Valley filed an emergency operations plan (the "Plan") in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code ("TAC") § 25.53 on April 18, 2022 and supplemented this filing on April 20, 2022.
- 4. An annual review of the Plan was completed, and no changes were made to the Plan in 2023 that materially affect how Flower Valley would respond to an emergency.
- 5. All relevant operating personnel are familiar with and have received training on the applicable contents and execution of the Plan, and such personnel are instructed to follow the applicable portions of the Plan except to the extent deviations are appropriate as a result of specific circumstances during the course of an emergency.
- 6. The Plan has been reviewed and approved by the appropriate executives.
- 7. Flower Valley conducted a drill on February 28, 2024.
- 8. The Plan or an appropriate summary has been distributed to local jurisdictions as needed.
- 9. Flower Valley maintains a business continuity plan that addresses returning to normal operations after disruptions caused by an incident.
- 10. Flower Valley's emergency management personnel who are designated to interact with local, state, and federal emergency management officials during emergency events have received the latest IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, and IS-800 National Incident Management System training.
