

The §25.53 Electric Service Emergency Operations Plans Rule is applicable to COB.



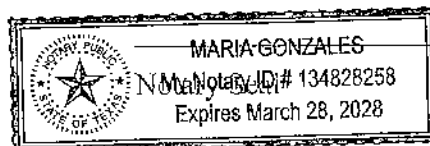

I, David Vaughn, swear or affirm that as a Municipally Owned Utility operating in the State of Texas and the Electric Reliability Council of Texas (ERCOT) region and control system, confirms the following:

"I am the City Manager for the City of Burnet (COB), which is an incorporated municipality in the State of Texas."

COB operates an electric distribution utility system in the State of Texas and the Electric Reliability Council of Texas power region.

The Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) developed to comply with the updated 16 TAC §25.53. Electric Service Emergency Operations Plan Rule, has been distributed to COB Managers and Operations personnel;

COB executives and Operations personnel have received training on the updated EOP;


Drills have been conducted to the extent required by 16 TAC §25.53(f);

COB has a Business Continuity Plan related to returning to normal operations after an emergency event or situation;

COB's emergency management personnel who are designated to interact with local, state, and federal emergency management officials during emergency events have received the latest IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, and IS-800 National Incident Management System training.
