To the Public Utility Commission of Texas:

Pursuant to section 25.53 of the Public Utility Commission of Texas' (PUCT) regulations, 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 25.53, Mars Solar, LLC (Mars Solar) hereby submits its annual update regarding Mars Solar's Emergency Operations Plan (EOP). Mars Solar is registered as a Power Generating Company with the PUCT in accordance with PUCT Chapter 25 § 25.53(c), with PGC Registration #20486.

In the previous year, Mars Solar did not make a change to its most recently submitted EOP. Therefore, as is required by § 25.53(c)(B), Mars Solar provides the following: (1) a pleading that affirms no changes have been made to its list of emergency contacts; (2) an attestation from Mars Solar's highest-ranking representative with binding authority over Mars Solar stating that it did not make a change to its most recent EOP; and (3) an affidavit as required under § 25.53(c)(4)(C).
