BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared who swore an oath that the following facts are true:

1. My name is Tristan Grimbert. I am President & CEO at EDF Renewables, Inc. and the highest-ranking representative, official, or officer with binding authority over Spinning Spur Wind LLC (“Spinning Spur Wind”). I am over 18 years of age, of sound mind, and competent and authorized to make this affidavit on behalf of Spinning Spur Wind. I have personal knowledge of the matters described herein.
2. Spinning Spur Wind is registered with the Public Utility Commission of Texas as a power generation company. Spinning Spur Wind is a wholly owned subsidiary of EDF Renewables, Inc.
3. Spinning Spur Wind filed an emergency operations plan (the “Plan”) in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (“TAC”) § 25.53 on April 18, 2022 and supplemented this filing on April 20 and May 16, 2022.
4. An annual review of the Plan was completed, and no changes were made to the Plan during 2024 that materially affect how Spinning Spur Wind would respond to an emergency.
5. All relevant operating personnel are familiar with and have received training on the applicable contents and execution of the Plan, and such personnel are instructed to follow the applicable portions of the Plan except to the extent deviations are appropriate as a result of specific circumstances during the course of an emergency.
6. The Plan has been reviewed and approved by the appropriate executives.
7. Spinning Spur Wind conducted a drill on its Plan in calendar year 2024 in accordance with 16 TAC § 25.53(f).
8. The Plan or an appropriate summary has been distributed to local jurisdictions as needed.
9. Spinning Spur Wind maintains a business continuity plan that addresses returning to normal operations after disruptions caused by an incident.
10. Spinning Spur Wind emergency management personnel who are designated to interact with local, state, and federal emergency management officials during emergency events have received training similar in scope to the latest IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, and IS-800 National Incident Management System training.
