
BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared Judith E. Talavera, and being by me duly sworn, upon oath declared that the statements and capacity acted in are true and correct.

My name is Judith E. Talavera. I am over eighteen years of age and am competent to make this Affidavit. I am the President and Chief Operating Officer for AEP Texas Inc. (AEP Texas). The facts contained herein are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief:

- 1. All relevant operating personnel within AEP Texas are familiar with the contents of the emergency operations plan (EOP) and have received training on the applicable contents and execution of the EOP, and such personnel are instructed to follow the applicable portions of the EOP except to the extent deviations are appropriate as a result of specific circumstances during the course of an emergency;
- 2. The EOP has been reviewed and approved by the appropriate executives;
- 3. Drills will be conducted to the extent required by 16 TAC § 25.53(f);
- 4. The EOP or an appropriate summary will be distributed to local jurisdictions as needed;
- 5. AEP Texas maintains a business continuity plan that addresses returning to normal operations after disruptions caused by an incident; and
- 6. AEP Texas' emergency management personnel who are designated to interact with local, state, and federal emergency management officials during emergency events have received the IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, and IS-800 National Incident Management System training.
