**WESTOVER ESS ASSETS, LLC SUPPLEMENT TO  
EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:  
COMPLETION OF DRILL AND NIMS TRAINING**

On May 26, 2022, Westover ESS Assets, LLC (“Westover ESS”) filed its executive summary and redacted emergency operations plan (“EOP”) pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (“TAC”) § 25.53. In that filing, Westover ESS stated that it would file a supplement in this docket upon the completion of: (i) Westover ESS conducting a drill on its revised EOP by the end of the 2022 calendar year; and (ii) certain LG Energy Solutions personnel completing the latest IS-100, IS-200, IS-700 and IS-800 National Incident Management System (“NIMS”) training. Westover ESS hereby supplements its May 26, 2022 filing and states that it completed a drill on its EOP on June 8, 2022 and that the relevant personnel completed the latest IS-100, IS-200, IS-700 and IS-800 NIMS training.
