
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BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared William O. Perkins, III who swore an oath that the following facts are true:

1. My name is William O. Perkins, III. I am the President of Matta Power Station, LLC (“Matta Power”) and the highest-ranking officer with binding authority over Matta Power. I am over 18 years of age, of sound mind, and competent and authorized to make this affidavit on behalf of Matta Power. I have personal knowledge of the matters described herein.
2. Matta Power is registered with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (“PUCT”) as a power generation company, and the Matta Power facility is a battery energy storage system.
3. Matta Power filed an emergency operations plan (the “Plan”) in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (“TAC”) § 25.53 on May 18, 2022.
4. No changes have been made to Matta Power’s list of emergency contacts as provided under 16 TAC § 25.53(c)(4)(B) since Matta Power’s filing on May 18, 2022.
5. No changes have been made to the Plan that materially affect how Matta Power would respond to an emergency since Matta Power’s filing on May 18, 2022.
6. All relevant operating personnel are familiar with and have received training on the applicable contents and execution of the Plan, and such personnel are instructed to follow the applicable portions of the Plan except to the extent deviations are appropriate as a result of specific circumstances during the course of an emergency.
7. The Plan has been reviewed and approved by the appropriate executives.
8. Matta Power is still in the commissioning stage of development, with commercial operations expected in March 2023. Matta Power has provided notice to the PUCT Staff of its intent to conduct a drill on its Plan in accordance with 16 TAC § 25.53(f) by March 31, 2023.
9. The Plan or an appropriate summary has been distributed to local jurisdictions as needed.
10. Matta Power maintains a business continuity plan that addresses returning to normal operations after disruptions caused by an incident.

11. Matta Power's emergency management personnel who are designated to interact with local, state, and federal emergency management officials during emergency events have received the latest IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, and IS-800 National Incident Management System training.
