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BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared who swore an oath that the following facts are true:

1. My name is Tristan Grimbert. I am President & CEO at EDF Renewables, Inc. and the highest-ranking representative, official, or officer with binding authority over King Creek Wind Farm 1 LLC ("KC1"). I am over 18 years of age, of sound mind, and competent and authorized to make this affidavit on behalf of KC1. I have personal knowledge of the matters described herein.
2. KC1 is registered with the Public Utility Commission of Texas as a power generation company. KC1 is a wholly owned subsidiary of EDF Renewables, Inc.
3. KC1 filed an emergency operations plan (the "Plan") in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code ("TAC") § 25.53 on April 18, 2022 and supplemented this filing on April 20 and May 16, 2022.
4. No changes have been made to KC1's list of emergency contacts as provided under 16 TAC § 25.53(c)(4)(B) since KC1's filing on April 18, 2022 (as supplemented on April 20, 2022).
5. No changes were made to the Plan that materially affect how KC1 would respond to an emergency.
6. All relevant operating personnel are familiar with and have received training on the applicable contents and execution of the Plan, and such personnel are instructed to follow the applicable portions of the Plan except to the extent deviations are appropriate as a result of specific circumstances during the course of an emergency.
7. The Plan has been reviewed and approved by the appropriate executives.
8. KC1 conducted drills on its Plan on December 7, 2022, in accordance with 16 TAC § 25.53(f).
9. The Plan or an appropriate summary has been distributed to local jurisdictions as needed.
10. KC1 maintains a business continuity plan that addresses returning to normal operations after disruptions caused by an incident.
11. KC1 emergency management personnel who are designated to interact with local, state, and federal emergency management officials during emergency events have

received the latest IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, and IS-800 National Incident Management System training.
