## ORDER NO. 3 FINDING APPLICATION, AS SUPPLEMENTED, ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the February 22, 2022 application of CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC (CSWR Texas) and Water Works I and II for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate of convenience and necessity rights in Llano County. The requested area for this docket includes 84 customer connections and approximately 137 acres of transferred area from Water Works I and II. On April 5, 6, 19, and 28, 2022, the applicants filed supplements to the application.

On May 6, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding completeness of the application and notice.

The ALJ finds the application, as supplemented, administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner described in and attached to Patricia Garcia's memorandum dated May 6, 2022, using the included forms.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:
