ORDER NO. 13 GRANTING SECOND EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMPLETE TRANSACTION

This Order addresses CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC's May 30, 2023 second request to extend the 180-day deadline to complete the transaction that is the subject of this application. CSWR-Texas states that additional time is needed due to real estate title issues that are currently being addressed by title insurance companies. CSWR-Texas represents that Commission Staff is not opposed.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) grants CSWR-Texas's request for extension. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.239(m), the ALJ extends deadline for the parties to complete their transaction to September 18, 2023.¹

CSWR-Texas and Water Works I and II must continue to file a monthly update regarding the status of closing and submit documents as evidence that the transaction was completed, if applicable. In the next monthly status update, CSWR-Texas and Water Works I and II must provide an anticipated timeline for closing.

¹ The 90-day deadline, from June 19, 2023, ends on Sunday September 17, 2023, which is a Sunday; therefore, under 16 TAC § 22.4(a), the deadline moves to the next day the Commission is open for business, or Monday, September 18, 2023.
