**ORDER NO. 14**  
**GRANTING THIRD EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMPLETE TRANSACTION**

This Order addresses CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC's September 6, 2023 third request to extend the 180-day deadline to complete the transaction that is the subject of this application. CSWR-Texas states that additional time is needed to close the transaction. CSWR-Texas represents that Commission Staff is not opposed. CSWR-Texas represents that Commission Staff is not opposed. CSWR-Texas also states that it anticipates that the transaction will close around the end of September 2023.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) grants CSWR-Texas's third request for extension. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.239(m), the ALJ extends deadline for the parties to complete their transaction to October 18, 2023.

CSWR-Texas and Water Works I and II must continue to file a monthly update regarding the status of closing and submit documents as evidence that the transaction was completed, if applicable. In the next monthly status update, if necessary, CSWR-Texas and Water Works I and II must provide an anticipated timeline for closing.
