FINDING SUPPLEMENTAL PROOF OF NOTICE SUFFICIENT**


This Order addresses the supplemental proof of notice filed by CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company LLC. On April 30, 2024, CSWR-Texas filed, among other things, the affidavit of Eric Rocchio, regulatory case manager for CSWR-Texas, attesting that there are no landowners owning tracts of land over 25 acres wholly or partly inside the requested area at issue in this proceeding.
