ORDER NO. 3 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of Undine Texas, LLC's proof of notice. On June 17, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding Undine Texas's provision of notice.

On June 3, 2022, Undine Texas filed proof that notice was (a) provided to current customers, landowners, neighboring utilities, cities, and affected parties, along with maps, on May 3, 2022; and (b) published in the *Fort Bend Herald*, a newspaper of general circulation in Fort Bend County, on May 5 and 12, 2022.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient.

 $^{^1}$ Under 16 TAC § 24.235(a)(3), the intervention period is 30 days from the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later, unless otherwise provided by the presiding officer. Notice was mailed on May 3, 2022 and published on May 5, 2022 and May 12, 2022. Therefore, 30 days after May 12, 2022 is June 11, 2022. However, since June 11, 2022 is a Saturday, a day which the Commission is not open for business, 16 TAC § 22.4(a) establishes that the deadline to intervene is the next day the Commission is open for business, June 13, 2022.
