JOINT MOTION TO ADMIT SUPPLEMENTAL EVIDENCE

I. Background

On November 4, 2022, Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission (Commission) and Applicant Undine Texas LLC (Undine) (collectively, the Parties) filed their Joint Motion to Admit Evidence pursuant to Order No. 6. On November 22, 2022, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 7, requiring the Parties to file a corrected joint supplemental motion to admit evidence with a revised tariff. On November 22, 2022, the Parties filed a Supplemental Motion to Admit Evidence with a revised tariff. On December 29, 2022, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 8 requiring Undine Texas LLC and Commission Staff to provide additional clarification, recommendations and possibly additional documentation in this application. On January 20, 2023 and January 24, 2023, Applicant filed its Supplemental Financial Information and Staff's Response to Order No. 8 was filed on February 27, 2023. Parties filed their Supplemental Motion to Admit Evidence on March 2, 2023. On April 25, 2023, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 12 Admitting Evidence. April 28, 2023, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 13, requiring Parties file a supplemental motion to admit evidence on or before May 5, 2023, regarding the inclusion of supplemental information filed by Undine on January 20, 2023 and January 24, 2023. On May 5, 2023, the Parties filed their Joint Motion to Admit Evidence Pursuant to Order No. 13. On May 8, 2023, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 14 Admitting Evidence. On May 18, 2023, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 16 Requiring Additional Clarification, requiring Undine to file its Capital Improvements Plan and Notice. On June 15, 2023, Applicant filed its Response to Order No. 16. On June 16, 2023, Applicant filed its Supplemental Information. On July 17, 2023, Staff filed its Recommendation on Capital Improvement

Plan and Sufficiency of Supplemental Notice in response to Order No. 16. On July 26, 2023, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 17, requiring the Parties to file a Joint Motion to Admit Supplemental Evidence by August 2, 2023. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. Joint Motion to Admit Supplemental Evidence

Parties move to admit the following supplemental evidence into the record of evidence in this proceeding:

Applicant's filings in response to Order No. 16 and Supplemental Information, filed on June 15-16, 2023 (Interchange Item Nos. 57-60); and

Staff's Recommendation on Capital Improvement Plan and Sufficiency of Supplemental Notice in response to Order No. 16 with Confidential Attachment FB-1, filed July 17, 2023 (Interchange Item Nos. 61-62).


