ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING
NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the April 1, 2022 application of Undine Texas LLC to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity in Fort Bend County.

On May 2, 2022, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on administrative completeness and proposed a procedural schedule.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs the petitioners to provide notice of the application as described in the May 2, 2022 memorandum of Patricia Garcia attached to Commission Staff's recommendation, using the included forms.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:
