COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On April 8, 2022, Undine Texas LLC (Undine) filed an application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 13260 in Jackson County. Undine requests the amendment to add a residential community development consisting of 97 lots.

On July 12, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 3, which directed Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice by September 6, 2022. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff needs more time to review Undine's notice documents and prepare the required recommendation. Accordingly, Staff respectfully requests an extension of time until September 20, 2022 to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice.

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the above request for extension.
