ORDER NO. 8
ADMITTING EVIDENCE AND REQUIRING CLARIFICATION

I. Admitting Evidence

This Order addresses the January 13, 2023 joint motion to admit evidence. The administrative law judge grants the motion and admits the following evidence into the record:

1. The application and all attachments filed on April 8 and 11, 2022;
2. Undine's application supplement filed on May 12, 2022;
3. Commission Staff's supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness and notice and proposed procedural schedule filed on July 11, 2022;
4. Affidavits of public notice filed on August 25, 2022;
5. Supplemental affidavits of public notice filed on September 19, 2022;
6. Undine's application supplement filed on September 22, 2022;
7. Commission Staff's recommendation on sufficiency of notice filed on September 27, 2022;
8. Undine's consent form filed on November 8, 2022;
9. Undine's application supplement filed on November 15, 2022;
10. Commission Staff's final recommendation on the application filed November 17, 2022; and
11. The final map, certificate, and tariff as attached to the joint motion to admit evidence and proposed notice of approval filed on January 13, 2023.

II. Clarification

In the parties joint motion to admit evidence, the parties did not seek to admit Undine's application supplement and confidential exhibit A filed on September 21, 2022. It appears that this item is referenced in Commission Staff's final recommendation.

By February 3, 2023, the parties must identify whether these filings should be admitted as evidence and if not, provide a clarification, as to why the evidence does not need admitted. If the parties seek to admit this evidence, they must file a supplemental motion to admit the evidence.
