## ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the April 8, 2022 application of Undine Texas LLC to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 13260 in Jackson County. On April 11, 2022, Undine filed confidential, supplemental information. On May 5, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on administrative completeness and notice.

The administrative law judge finds the petition administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider a petition filed until it makes a determination that it is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the petition is not considered filed with the Commission.

By June 9, 2022, the petitioners must supplement the petition to cure the deficiencies as described in the May 5, 2022 memoranda of Patricia Garcia and Jorge Ordonez. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the petition cannot proceed. The petitioners must not issue notice until the petition is deemed administratively complete.

By July 11, 2022, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the petition, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
